## School Information

Students have the option to eat breakfast in the cafeteria each morning. Breakfast is provided free of charge for all students at the elementary school.

Lunch prices are \$1.90. Students may have seconds on fruits and vegetables, but additional main courses or drinks must be purchased. You may send money with your student or post funds into their account via the Melba School District website. Using the online payment does include a service charge. You may pay with cash or check at the school office, we are not able to process debit or credit cards at the school.

If you are unable to locate the school supply list that was sent home with report cards, you may pick one up at the school office, the district office, or find it on the website.

Our school hours for the 2019-2020 school year will be 8:00 – 3:45. Please do not drop off students prior to 7:45 – that is when supervision begins. Please remember for the safety of all of our students we would like parents to pick up and drop off their students traveling west on 6<sup>th</sup> Street or traveling south on Carrie Rex. **Please do not drop off or pick up students so that they have to cross the street.** Buses will drop off students at the cafeteria on the north side of the building. If you are unsure of your child's bus route, please contact the elementary school for further information.
