The situation continues to change and is fluid. After conversations with the State Department of Education, members from the governor's office, CDC and school districts around us the Melba School District will close schools starting on Wednesday March 18, 2020. Office staff in the elementary, high school, and district office will still be here at the schools to answer any questions you may have. The IHSAA postponed and canceled athletic events, including practice, starting tomorrow through the 5th of April.

While we work towards a solution for students should this school closure be prolonged, the district will have curriculum created that will be distributed out to students. With the fluid changes that are happening by the hour in some instances, the School board will be meeting next Wednesday, March 25 at 5pm to determine the direction of the school. We have spring break next week and this will allow time for us to make informed decisions.

Safety is our main concern and we continue to act on the information that is presented to us. We will continue to work closely with our community, surrounding school districts, state and local government, and the CDC.
