Honesty and transparency make you vulnerable...

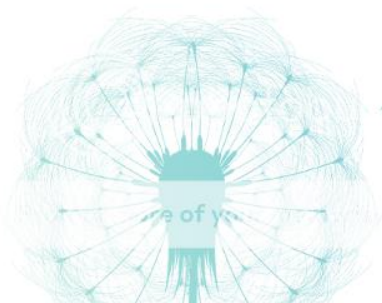
Be honest and transparent anyway.
