## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

  - Applicants will be informed of whether they have been chosen to receive the scholarship by May 10, 2024. Scholarship will be awarded in the form of a check made payable to the student and the institution the applicant plans to attend.
  - The amount of the Scholarship award will be \$1000.00 and will be awarded to one applicant.

## APPLICATION INFORMATION

Application for the scholarship may be either typed or hand written and must be signed by the applicant. In the case of a minor, the signature of a parent or guardian should also be included. The application should include:

- 1) A personal essay outlining educational and or vocational goals.
- 2) The name and address of the institution of higher learning you are planning to attend.
- 3} A list of church, school, and community activities you have been involved in {and offices held}.
- 4) An official high school transcript.
- 5} A brief statement of financial need.
- 6} It will be to your advantage to inform the scholarship committee of any other factors that might help in the evaluation of your application.
- 7} Two letters of recommendations from individuals who are not related to you. One of the letters should be from a school counselor or teacher.
- 8) Your name and mailing address and telephone number.
